On receipt of EAS Sanction, during issuance contract/award though GeM Portal, this office revealed that M/s. Jaiswal Brothers (GeM system selected L-1 Bidder), didn't accepted that offer issued by GeM Portal.

This office raised the query to GeM Portal helpdesk and requested for further course of action as per rules in vogue. It has been informed by the GeM Helpdesk that, as per GeM Portal it has shown that "Bidder did not respond" which suggests that M/s. Jaiswal Brothers (GeM system selected L-1 Bidder), bid shall be rejected automatically. This office intimated vide letter No. संख्या/ No. E/1/21/Sanitation/IAF/2023-24/EAS/Manpower दिनांक/Date: 02.01.2024 to M/s. Jaiswal Brothers (GeM system selected L-1 Bidder), as well as to The AF Stn Barrackpore.

Hence, as per GeM system selected Re-Run L-1 selection option only exist. The Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC), also decided to follow the guidelines & instruction, issued by the GeM Portal itself.

Reference GeM Bid No. GEM/2023/B/4200936 dated 11.11.2023, wherein the ibid GeM bid was uploaded pertains to services for providing of manpower (unskilled & skilled). And, therefore, GeM system selected Re-Run L-1 selection option selected. Whereas, M/s. Tapas Roy, was selected as GeM system selected L-1 Bidder.

This office forwarded the Statement of Case to the AF Station, Barrackpore, vide letter No. संख्या/ No. E/1/21/Sanitation/IAF/2023-24/EAS/Re-Run L-1 Option दिनांक/Date:02.01.2024.

Chowdhury Construction (viz. for Manpower services, in which GeM Bid approved by the IFA Kolkata for similar category of conservancy services to the LMA/Stn Hqtr Barrackpore, w.e.f. 01.11.2023 onwards), for this transition phase i.e. only 02 (two) days w.e.f. 02.01.2024 to 03.01.2024.

On 04.01.2024, onwards the services shall be provided by the GeM system selected L-1 bidder i.e. M/s. Tapas Roy, as approved by the CFA. Hence, all other integral conservancy services were continued as per existing contracts with the Board.

On 09.01.2024 onwards M/s. Subha Chakraborty, (GeM system selected L-1 Bidder), execute the services for providing 01 (one) no. of conservancy vehicle for the AF station Barrackpore.

In this regard, requisite documents of both the above GeM Bid documents alongwith AON & EAS sanction/approval of the CFA (Competent Financial Authority) are placed before the Board for its noting.

Due to paucity of fund, to run the Solid Waste Management Plant at trenching ground, minimal work was executed by the Board. Whereas, the e-tender was already approved by the Board.

Reference, request letter submitted by the existing bidder i.e. M/s. Shivam Construction dated 31.07.2023 wherein it has been intimated that the below mentioned works related to the periphery of Solid Waste Management Plant at Trenching Ground already constructed for safety running of Solid Waste Management Plant and the said work(s). The indispensable balance work(s) were completed which are integral part of the NIT, for the said services wherein to execute the ibid work/services as stipulated in the Technical Bid & Financial Bid inter-alia approved by the Competent Authority i.e. Board.

M/s. Shivam Construction that constructed alongwith its repair and maintenance works completed to execute of the original work order, which were supervised by firm's BE, Civil Engineer, engaged by the existing bidder i.e. M/s. Shivam Construction.

The works related with civil, electrical works were as below:

- i. Boundary of SWM Plant periphery
- ii. Upper & Monsoon shed
- iii. Flooring area
- iv. Segregation Platform
- v. Provisions for adequate water facility
- vi. Office cum Administrative rooms
- vii. Guard rooms with laboratory facility
- viii. All necessary electric panel
- ix. Foundation for set up of weighbridge etc. & all related civil works
- x. Complete electrification of shed, plant, machinery at Trenching Plant site
- xi. Preparation of Primary Compost pits, Secondary Compost Pits, Pits for Manure/Final Compost conservations, segregated unit/blocks for dry waste & wet waste facility also Bio-degradable waste & Non-Bio degradable waste.
- xii. Preparation of segregated unit/blocks for hazardous waste, sanitary waste, Construction & Demolition waste and E-waste.
- xiii. Construction of PCC floor for carrying segregation of waste.
- xiv. The requisite documents in r/o balance work(s) related with civil works, electrical works, plumbing works, sanitation works & materials related with stores were put into operation, to run the existing Solid Waste Management Plant of the Board.

President Cantonment Board Barrackpore Based on the above stated facts as well as the considering urgency of the ibid conservancy services & pursuant consolidated instructions in the light of CVC Guidelines & as per Rules of GFR 2017, this office seeking opinion from the CBLA (Cantonment Board Legal Advisor), vide letter संख्या/No. E/1/21/SWM/SUDA/2023-24/CBLA दिनांक/Dated 17.11.2023.

The opinion of the CBLA received vide letter dated 22.11.2023 is as hereto:

"In my opinion it is not a question as to whether the Cantonment Board can make the payment to the contractor. In fact, the Board is legally bound to make payment of any work carried out by the contractoras long as the same is within the scipe of original Tende. After, having to reslove the grant of balancework, the Board cannot refuse to make payment only on ground that some item of work wasecuted before the same was granted to the contractor. The question as to whether the balance payment can be made as arrears or current payment is hyper technical. As and when bill is submitted by a contractor the Board is only entitled to see whether the work has been satisfactory completed. After a work order is issued and after proper enquiry/scrutiny it is found that the work has been satisfactorily completed, the Board is fully liable to make payment.

The apprehension/question as to whether the aforesaid measures could be challenged, is not understood. There are only two parties to the contract, the Board and the Contractor. No third party can challenge the payment made to the contractor. On the other hand, if the query is regarding whether the such payment can called into question, I have already opined that the Board is contractually/legally bound for making payment for the work done by the contractor. Not making such payment could invite legal action from the contractor. The Board cannot legally expect to become the owners of the machinery and equipment without making any payment for the same.

As such I do not find any infirmity/illegality in the action proposed (and already resolved) by the Board in making payment to the contractor as long as the items of work has been satisfactorily executed/completed."

Hence, Board may noted here that, on the basis of actual cost to be incurred for development of the peripheral area of the Solid Waste Management (SWM), for set up civil, electrical works and all other works including sanitary items and stores items inter-alia approved by the Board. The firm's prayer to make necessary payment as per e-tender quoted rate received and approved by the Board vide CBR No. 01 dated 07.05.2022. In this regard, Security Money 10% of total payable amount shall also be kept to safe guard Board's interest and it may also be refunded after completion of the contract.

In this regard, necessary documents alongwith Govt. instruction(s)/orders and Report of CBLA are placed before the Board for its consideration and approval.

E-TENDER FOR SELECTION OF CONCESSIONAIRE FOR BIOMINING AND BIOREMEDIATION OF LEGACY WASTE AND RECLAMATION OF THE LAND AT SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLANT TRENCHING GROUND

E-tender had been invited by the Board vide GeM Bid No. GEM/2023/B/4217270 dated 16.11.2023 for selection of concessionaire for biomining and bioremediation of legacy waste and reclamation of the land at Solid Waste Management Plant Trenching Ground.

In view of above, total 05 (five) nos. of firm submitted the ibid GeM tender in due date & time. During scrutiny by the Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC) that No bidder had submitted the requisite documents as mentioned in Technical Bid or ATC. Each 05 (five) bidders have some shortfall in documents as required as per ATC. Hence, all the participants GeM bidders were given opportunity of additional 02 (two) days' time period as per GeM protocol, but its evaluated by Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC), that No bidder had submitted the requisite documents for providing the ibid service.

Hence, the Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC) recommends rejecting the all bids and called for fresh e-tender, after proper survey of measuring quantum of garbage to get more bidders and a competitive rate to execute the selection of concessionaire for bioremediation of legacy waste and reclamation of the land at Solid Waste Management Plant Trenching Ground of Cantonment Board Barrackpore. Although, it is in a very small scale comparing to similar nature of works related with other Govt. Institutions/ULB.

Hence, Board shall consider to utilize different kind of mechanized machine/mechanized equipment be engaged to reduce the quantity of accumulated garbage before arrival of the monsoon seasons in this region, so that accumulation of legacy waste garbage with foul odour to the local neighbours may be avoided. In this regard, the expenditure shall be borne, fund allotted under the Solid Waste Management Infrastructure Development Head by the SUDA through XV FC.
