Accordingly, proposal was submitted to the PDDE,EC vide this office letter No.C/III/IE/44 dated 17.02.2025 for obtaining sanction to fill up 13 vacant posts under various heads which are essential in nature. However, PDDE has advised that filling up the proposed 13 posts would create additional financial liability of Rs.57.38 lakhs per annum on Board. Cantt Board Barrackpore is an aided Board and needs Grant-in-aid from DG DE/MoD to meet statutory expenses.

As advised by the PDDE, matter has been examined on the proposal earlier sent by this office to fill up 13 vacant posts. After considering all the aspects including additional financial liability and the urgency of filling up posts on the basis of necessity, it is therefore, proposed to fill up only the following four feeder posts to run the office smoothly. To fill up the above mentioned posts, financial implication for the Board would be as under:

A total of 11 (eleven) nos. of participants submitted bids in due date and time on the GeM.

Upon thorough scrutiny, the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC), found out that only 02 (two) no. of bidders had submitted the requisite documents as per ATC and found them to be technically qualified.

And, whereas, query/clarification raised an additional 02 (two) days' time period was allowed through GeM portal on 28.02.2025 to submit the remaining documents as per ATC (Additional Terms and Conditions), to the balance 09 (nine) no. of bidders, within specified period.

In view of the above, as per office report, it is felt essential to get the two registers verified by an expert in the subject matter for finalization of reservation roster. Matter is placed before the Board to engage expert in this regard.

Office Note: Unauthorised Construction at Holding No. 7 Marrium Mahal, Sadar Bazar, Barrackpore was detected by the field staff of this office on 19.02.2014.

Notice under section 247 of the Cantonments Act, 2006 was issued on 20.02.2014 with a direction to stop the illegal activities forthwith. Whereas, Shri Mohan Pramanick (occupier) of Holding No. 7 Marrium Mahal, Sadar Bazar did not comply with the direction issued under section 247 of the Cantonments Act, 2006. Subsequently, this office had issued notice under section 248(1) of the Cantonments Act, 2006, dt. 11.04.2014 directing him to demolish the illegal construction within 30 days from the date receipt of the said notice.

Shri Mohan Pramanick vide his letter dt. 16.04.2014 had made an appeal u/s 340 of the Cantonments Act, 2006 before Dte, DE EC against Notice issued under section 248(1) of the Cantonments Act, 2006, dt. 11.04.2014.

The Dte, DE EC vide their letter No. 363049/BKP/APPEAL/MP/7/LC-3/DE/4, dt. 06.02.2024 has directed to submit parawise comments against appeal under section 340 of the Cantonments Act, 2006 made by Shri Mohan Pramanick, occupier of Holding No. 7 Marrium Mahal, Sadar Bazar, Barrackpore.

In this regard, draft parawise reply against the appeal u/s 340 of the Cantonments Act, 2006 is put up for approval of the Board.

RESOLUTION: Considered and Approved. Parawise Comments be forwarded to Dte, DE EC and C.E.O is authorized to take necessary action.

Both the Sanitary Inspector(s) of the Board were appointed in the pay scale of Rs. 3800-100-4100-125-4725-150-6375-175-7775/- (as per ROPA, 1998 of Govt. of West Bengal inter-alia as per 4^{th} Pay Commission of Govt. of West Bengal (as per ROPA, 1998 of Govt. of West Bengal).

Both the Sanitary Inspector(s) of the Board requested for revision of pay scale at par with Sanitary Inspector of Health Department, Govt. of West Bengal.

Hence, this Office vide letter No. C/III/94/240 dated 12.09.2002, requested to Assistant Chief Medical Officer of Health, North 24 Parganas to confirm the initial pay scale of Sanitary Inspector in Govt. of West Bengal.

In response of above-mentioned letter, Assistant Chief Medical Officer of Health, North 24 Parganas confirmed the initial pay scale of Sanitary Inspector (as per ROPA, 1998 of Govt. of West Bengal) is as follows:

Sanitary Inspector(s) play a crucial role in maintaining public health, hygiene, and sanitation within the territorial limit of Barrackpore Cantonment in both civil area and military unit areas. In addition to this Cantonment Board Barrackpore has been providing the conservancy services to Air Force Station Barrackpore, Air Force Camp Kanchrapara, Air Force Camp Jaffarpore, Hindustan Aeronautics Limited Barrackpore and Office of the Directorate, Defence Estates, Eastern Command.

With the introduction of many government initiatives the responsibilities of Sanitary Inspector(s) have expanded manifolds, are as follows:

- a. Implementation of Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM)
- b. Open Defecation Free (ODF) Certification
- c. Swachh Survekshan
- d. Garbage-Free Cities (GFC)
- e. Conducting cleanliness drives in public spaces, residential areas, and government institutions
- f. Monitoring and enforcing waste segregation at source and promoting Solid Waste Management practices
- g. Ensuring proper disposal of biomedical and hazardous Waste in compliance with government regulations
- h. Open Defecation Free (ODF) Certification
- i. Conducting awareness programs to encourage behavioral changes regarding sanitation practices
- j. Compliance of Solid Waste Management at trenching Ground.
