


The Ophthalmology and Physiotherapy Units have been introduced at J.C. Bose General Hospital, Barrackpore, with the assistance of ICICI Foundation under CSR funds and were inaugurated on 08.01.2026. Accordingly, one Ophthalmologist, one Optometrist, and a Physiotherapist have been engaged on a contractual basis for providing services in these units.

The newly appointed Physiotherapist and Optometrist have generously requested on 08.01.2026 for revision of their monthly remuneration, as per the norms prescribed by the West Bengal State Health & Family Welfare Samiti, vide Memo No. HFW-27011/137/2020/1352 dated 29.12.2020.

Accordingly, it may be noted that the West Bengal State Health & Family Welfare Samiti, vide Memo No. HFW-27011/137/2020/1352 dated 29.12.2020, has revised the remuneration of Physiotherapists @ Rs. 25,000/- per month and Optometrists @ Rs. 18,000/- per month. The same remuneration is proposed to be adopted with effect from 07.01.2026 for the newly deployed Physiotherapist and Optometrist at J.C. Bose General Hospital, Barrackpore.

Further, at present, the consultancy fee in other polyclinic units, namely Medicine, Gynaecologist, and Dentist, is Rs. 80/- (Rupees eighty only) per consultation. Accordingly, it is proposed that the consultancy fee for the Ophthalmology and Physiotherapy Units may also be fixed at Rs. 80/- (Rupees eighty only) per consultation.

Resolved further that the Chief Executive Officer be and is hereby authorised to take all necessary action in this regard for implementation of the above decisions.





AGENDA NO.4:**PROCUREMENT OF LED STREET LIGHTS FOR CANTONMENT AREA**

It is submitted that a total of 674 LED street lights are presently installed within the Cantonment Area. These lights were primarily procured during the financial year 2018-19, with a few additional lights procured subsequently as and when required. As per the report submitted by the contractual electricians, approximately 159 LED street lights have now become defunct within the Cantonment limits, causing considerable inconvenience to the public and adversely affecting civic amenities.

In order to restore proper illumination and ensure public safety, procurement at lease of 100 new LED street lights is proposed. The approximate cost per light is ₹3,500.00, and the total estimated expenditure for 100 lights works out to ₹3,50,000.00.





BIOMINING AND BIO-REMEDICATION OF LEGACY WASTE AND RECLAMATION OF THE LAND AT SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLANT AT TRENCHING GROUND OF CANTONMENT BOARD BARRACKPORE

It is informed that a contour survey was conducted by the Board to ascertain the quantity of total accumulated legacy waste. As per the contour survey, the total legacy waste was assessed at 37,790 MT, out of which 8,969 MT has already been biominced and the land reclaimed by the Board.

Now, it is proposed to invite a fresh e-tender for biomincing and bio-remediation of the remaining legacy waste and reclamation of land at the Solid Waste Management Plant, Trenching Ground, Cantonment Board, Barrackpore, as per the details given below:



SUPPLY, COMMISSIONING AND INSTALLATION OF REFUSE DERIVED FUEL (RDF) BRIQUETTE PRODUCTION SYSTEM AT SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLANT AT TRENCHING GROUND

The existing Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) processing facility is proposed to be upgraded to enhance its processing capacity and to ensure scientific and environmentally compliant management of solid waste generated within the Cantonment area. With the increase in waste generation, it has become necessary to adopt advanced and sustainable waste processing solutions.

At present, a considerable quantity of segregated non-biodegradable and high-calorific-value waste is left unutilized, which ultimately requires disposal at landfill sites. This not only increases operational and transportation costs but also leads to environmental concerns and reduced landfill life.

The establishment of a Refuse Derived Fuel (RDF) briquette production system will enable conversion of combustible waste into usable fuel briquettes. These briquettes can be supplied to cement plants and other industries as an alternative fuel, thereby ensuring productive utilization of waste and reducing dependency on landfill disposal.

The proposed system will significantly reduce the volume of waste sent to landfills, improve overall operational efficiency of the MSW plant, and help in achieving environmental compliance. It will also generate sustainable revenue through sale of RDF briquettes and contribute towards a cost-effective solid waste management mechanism.

The proposal is in alignment with the objectives of the Swachh Bharat Mission and national waste-to-energy initiatives, which emphasize reduction, reuse, recycling, and recovery of resources from waste.

The total estimated cost for procurement, installation, and commissioning of the RDF briquette production system is ~₹48.00 Lakhs, which includes the cost of machinery, accessories, installation, and allied works.

In view of the above, the establishment of an RDF briquette production system is essential for sustainable and scientific management of solid waste. The Board is requested to consider the proposal and accord approval for implementation of the project at an estimated cost of ₹48.00 Lakhs.





The Office of the Dy. Chief Engineer (E), Indira Gandhi Water Treatment Plant, Water Supply Department, Kolkata Municipal Corporation, vide Memo No. WW/IGWTP/322/2024-25 dated 07.12.2024, has informed that water charges are to be borne at the rate of ₹4.60 per kiloliter instead of ₹1.50 per kiloliter with effect from 01.11.2019 towards consumption of potable water.


In response this office vide letter No. F/V/8C/KMC/BILLS/5 dated 17.12.2024, informed the Office of the Dy. 



PREPARATION OF DETAILED PROJECT REPORT (DPR) AND ENGAGEMENT OF IIT-KHARAGPUR AND INDEPENDENT SURVEY AGENCY FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF COMPREHENSIVE DOOR-TO-DOOR SEWERAGE NETWORK SYSTEM WITH SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT (STP) IN BARRACKPORE CANTONMENT

Board with reference to DGDE letter No. 25/Misc./C/DE/2004 dated 09.05.2017 as conveyed vide PDDE EC letter No. 362595/Swachh Bharat/LC-3/II/36 dated 23.05.2017, Swachh Survekshan-2024 guidelines wherein scientific wastewater management forms an essential and integral component under Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM), DGDE letter No. 76/67/Manual Scavengers/C/DE/2024 Vol-IX dated 23.12.2024 as conveyed vide PDDE EC letter No. 362595/Swachh Bharat/LC-3/XI dated 23.12.2024 regarding implementation of the provisions of The Employment as Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Act, 2013, and the Minute Sheet issued vide PDDE EC letter No. 362595/Swachh Bharat/LC-3/XI/32 dated 13.02.2025, wherein the CEO, Cantonment Board, Barrackpore highlighted serious concerns regarding the absence of an integrated Sewerage Network and Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) within Barrackpore Cantonment for scientific treatment and disposal of sewage and night soil.

At present, sanitation infrastructure within Barrackpore Cantonment largely depends on septic tanks; soak pits and cesspool cleaning operations, which is neither sustainable nor compliant with the long-term environmental objectives and directives of the Ministry of Defence. The existing system results in operational constraints in disposal of sewage collected from septic tanks and sewer lines and poses risks of environmental pollution. In this context, the establishment of a comprehensive door-to-door underground Sewerage Network along with a dedicated Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) has become imperative to ensure scientific, hygienic and environmentally compliant wastewater management in the Cantonment area.

Cantonment Board, Barrackpore has achieved Rank No. 23 in Swachh Survekshan-2024 and has been certified as ODF+ and Garbage Free City (GFC) – 3 Star Rating. To sustain these achievements and further enhance sanitation standards in line with national benchmarks, the creation of an integrated Sewerage Network with STP facility covering Civil Area, Bungalow Area and Army Area of the Cantonment is essential.

In furtherance of this objective, a meeting was held on 07.01.2025 with Dr. Partha Sarathi Ghosal, Assistant Professor, IIT-Kharagpur, wherein it was emphasized that the core objective of the project is to establish a new Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) facility along with a comprehensive door-to-door underground sewerage network covering the entire Cantonment area on priority basis. It was also deliberated that the use of septic tanks and soakage pits is to be completely discontinued and that the proposed system should be robust, sustainable and viable over a long period of time.





During the deliberations, it was proposed that an independent surveying agency be engaged for conducting a detailed survey, including contour survey, to ascertain gradients and land levels across the entire Cantonment area for preparation of a Detailed Project Report (DPR). It was further proposed that the DPR for the STP facility along with the comprehensive underground sewerage network shall be prepared by IIT-Kharagpur and that the survey and DPR shall be vetted by IIT-Kharagpur to ensure technical soundness, cost effectiveness and compliance with applicable environmental norms.

The proposed scope of the project shall include preparation of two separate DPRs by IIT, Kharagpur-one for the Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) facility along with a comprehensive door-to-door underground sewerage network covering the entire Cantonment area, including the Civil Area, Bungalow Area, and Army Area, and the other for storm water collection and treatment. The DPRs shall be prepared, covering technical, financial and implementation aspects of the Sewage Treatment Plant along with sewerage network and Storm Water Management, preparation of cost estimates, identification of suitable technology, preparation of tender documents on turnkey basis, inclusion of operation and maintenance provisions, and formulation of compliance mechanisms in line with Hon'ble National Green Tribunal order dated 30.04.2019 and MoEF&CC norms dated 13.10.2017. The selected vendor shall be responsible for detailed engineering designs, construction, commissioning and satisfactory performance of the STP and sewerage network, storm water management alongwith its vetting and periodic monitoring of the entire project by IIT-Kharagpur.


In this regard, all relevant documents including Minutes of Meeting dated 07.01.2025, correspondence made by this office and proposals relating to engagement of IIT-Kharagpur and an independent surveying agency for preparation of DPR for establishment of a comprehensive sewerage network system with STP Plant in Barrackpore Cantonment are placed before the Board for consideration and approval.



The proposed setup will be based on Nutrient Film Technique (NFT) with climate-controlled arrangements. The system will include uPVC NFT channels, nutrient tanks, motors, sensors for EC, pH, temperature and dissolved oxygen, auto-dosing mechanism, microprocessor control system and allied electrical and plumbing works, as per prescribed technical specifications.

The hydroponics system will allow controlled cultivation of crops with higher productivity, reduced water usage and minimal wastage of nutrients. It will also serve as a demonstration model for modern agricultural practices and promote sustainable food production.

The system requires limited area, ensures ease of maintenance, allows real-time monitoring of nutrient parameters and supports year-round cultivation under controlled conditions. It is environmentally friendly and suitable for efficient resource management.

The total estimated cost for supply, installation, testing and commissioning of the climate-controlled hydroponics system, including all accessories, sensors, tanks, motors, electrical and plumbing works, labour and warranty, is approximately ₹6.00 Lakhs.
