

During scrutiny by the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC), it was observed that the IP addresses of 02 (two) nos. of firms were marked red by the GeM due to IP address conflict.

This raised serious concerns regarding collusion, cartel formation, or bid rigging as per Clause 8.1.13 of the Manual for Procurement of Goods (Ministry of Finance) and this Office Part-II Order No. 117C dated 09.06.2023.

After careful scrutiny and deliberation, Technical Bid Evaluation Committee recommended to reject all the 02 (two) nos. of bids whose IP addresses were marked red by the GeM due to IP address conflict.

Hence, the Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC) recommended to evaluate the bids of only remaining 12 (twelve) nos. participating bidders.

During scrutiny by the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC), it was found that only 02 (two) nos. of firms submitted the requisite documents as per Additional Terms & Conditions (ATC) and found them technically qualified.

As per existing GeM protocol, additional 02 (two) days time period was granted to the remaining 10 (ten) nos. of firms to submit the requisite documents as per Additional Terms & Conditions (ATC).

Upon the expiry of additional 02 (two) days, time period, Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC) found that, out of 10 (ten) nos. of participating bidders, additional 03 (three) nos. of firms submitted the requisite documents as per ATC and found them technically qualified.



SUPPLY, COMMISSIONING AND INSTALLATION OF REFUSE DERIVED FUEL (RDF) BRIQUETTE PRODUCTION SYSTEM AT SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLANT AT TRENCHING GROUND

Reference CBR No. 13 dated 14.01.2026.

Board vide CBR No. 13 dated 14.01.2026, considered and approved to upgrade the existing Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) processing facility to enhance its processing capacity and to ensure scientific and environmentally compliant management of solid waste generated within the Cantonment area. With the increase in waste generation, it has become necessary to adopt advanced and sustainable waste processing solutions.

At present, a considerable quantity of segregated non-biodegradable and high-calorific-value waste is left unutilized, which ultimately requires disposal at landfill sites. This not only increases operational and transportation costs but also leads to environmental concerns and reduced landfill life.

The establishment of a Refuse Derived Fuel (RDF) briquette production system will enable conversion of combustible waste into usable fuel briquettes. These briquettes can be supplied to cement plants and other industries as an alternative fuel, thereby ensuring productive utilization of waste and reducing dependency on landfill disposal.



AGENDA 06:**PROPOSAL FOR OPENING OF BANK ACCOUNT FOR FUND ALLOTTED UNDER 15TH CENTRAL FINANCE COMMISSION**

Refer guidelines issued by the Director, SUDA vide their letter No. SUDA-1019/2022/587(3) dated 03.02.2023, regarding opening of Bank account for 15th Central Finance Commission.

With the approval of the Finance Department, the State Urban Development Agency has opened a Bank Account for receipt of allotment for 15th Finance Commission. As per the guidelines of Central Scheme and operational guidelines for 15th Finance Commission, each Urban Local Body (ULB) including Cantonment Board, eligible to receive the grant is required to open a Bank account in a Schedule Commercial Bank. Also, linking of this Bank Account with PFMS (Public Financial Management System) is the precondition for release of the grant.

And therefore, this office had opened an account for funds allotted under the 15th Finance Commission with Punjab National Bank, Barrackpore Bar Court Branch, since 08.02.2023.

And whereas, considering interest rate of other Schedule Commercial Bank, it has been reported that ICICI Bank has been providing higher interest returns against savings account compared to Punjab National Bank (PNB), which is *inter-alia*, financial benefit to the Board, as well. In addition to that, ICICI Bank may be considered more advantageous in providing superior Digital Banking Facilities, Faster Service & Processing etc.

In view of the above, it is proposed to switch the 15th CFC account from Punjab National Bank to ICICI Bank in the ensuing Financial Year i.e. 2026-27 for better financial support.

The matter is placed before the Board for consideration and approval.



AGENDA NO. 8: WORKS UNDERTAKEN UNDER JAL SANCHAY JAN BHAGIDARI 2.0 SCHEME

Reference DGDE Letter No. 76/67/Jal Sanchay Jan Bhagidari/C/DE/2025, dt. 05.03.2026 and Directorate, DE EC Letter No. 363051/JSJB/LC-3/1/20, dt. 09.03.2026. Detailed instructions have been received from higher authorities regarding the implementation of the *Jal Sanchay Jan Bhagidari (JSJB)* initiative. The initiative focuses on water conservation, rainwater harvesting, rejuvenation of water bodies, and sustainable groundwater management etc within the Cantonment area.

As per the directions, emphasis has been laid on community participation, convergence of resources, and time-bound execution of identified works to achieve visible outcomes under the campaign.

Initially, a total of 1470 works were identified for DGDE under the Jal Sanchay Jan Bhagidari (JSJB) initiative. Further, in order to ensure effective implementation and improved departmental performance, a target of 100 works has been fixed for Eastern Command for identification and completion of water conservation works. Out of this, Cantonment Board, Barrackpore has identified 26 works to be undertaken under JSJB 2.0.

These works broadly include:-

- Rainwater harvesting through pits and recharge structures
- Rejuvenation and desilting of existing water bodies
- Groundwater recharge initiatives at identified / feasible locations
- Repair and maintenance of drains/nallahs to improve water flow
- Installation of irrigation systems such as sprinklers in public parks
- Removal of aquatic weeds and cleaning of water bodies

The implementation strategy focuses on: -

- Expeditious execution within stipulated timelines
- Ensuring quality and sustainability of works
- Public awareness and involvement wherever feasible
- Regular monitoring and reporting of progress

E-tender had been invited by the Board for the provision of engagement of 18 (eighteen) nos. of different category of manpower (viz. unskilled/ semi-skilled/ skilled and highly skilled) at JC Bose General Hospital of Cantonment Board, Barrackpore for a period of 01 (one) year from the date of communication of acceptance of the tender, vide GeM Bid No. GEM/2026/B/7126135 dated 19.01.2026.

For the above, total 274 (two hundred seventy four) nos. of firms submitted the bid in due date and time.

In accordance with the procurement guidelines, a thorough evaluation was carried out by the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC), to ensure fairness, transparency, and compliance.

During scrutiny by the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC), it was observed that the IP addresses of 45 (forty five) nos. of firms were marked red by the GeM due to IP address conflict.

This raised serious concerns regarding collusion, cartel formation, or bid rigging as per Clause 8.1.13 of the Manual for Procurement of Goods (Ministry of Finance) and this Office Part-II Order No. 117C dated 09.06.2023.

After careful scrutiny and deliberation, Technical Bid Evaluation Committee recommended to reject all the 45 (forty five) nos. of bids whose IP addresses were marked red by the GeM due to IP address conflict.

Hence, the Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC) recommended to evaluate the bids of only remaining 229 (two hundred twenty nine) nos. participating bidders.

During scrutiny by the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC), it was found that only 09 (nine) nos. of firms submitted the requisite documents as per Additional Terms & Conditions (ATC) and found them technically qualified.

As per existing GeM protocol, additional 02 (two) days time period was granted to the remaining 220 (two hundred twenty) nos. of firms to submit the requisite documents as per Additional Terms & Conditions (ATC).

Upon the expiry of additional 02 (two) days, time period, Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC) found that, out of 220 (two hundred twenty) nos. of participating bidders, no firm submitted the requisite documents as per ATC and found them technically qualified.



As per recommendation of the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC), out of 274 (two hundred seventy four) nos. of bidders, only 09 (nine) nos. of bidders have been technically qualified and 265 (two hundred sixty five) nos. of bidders were rejected due not meeting the eligibility criteria as mentioned in Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) for providing the above mentioned service.

During the Financial Bid Evaluation, it was observed that all 09 (nine) nos. of technically qualified bidders had quoted the same minimum floor price and showing multiple "L-1". Accordingly, the "Run L-1 Selection" option was exercised for selection of the L-1 bidder. The details of the "Run L-1 Selection" are appended below for kind perusal.
