



AGENDA NO. 4: **APPROVAL OF AON SANCTION: OUTSOURCING OF EXTERNAL CONSERVANCY SERVICES AT AIR FORCE STATION, BARRACKPORE AND ITS LODGER UNITS FOR A PERIOD OF 01 (ONE) YEAR FROM THE DATE OF SIGNING OF CONTRACT**

Air Force Station, Barrackpore vide their letter No. 6W/843/1/Org dated 03.02.2026, conveyed the AON (Approval of Necessity) sanction accorded by the Competent Financial Authority (CFA) vide IFA HQ EAC AON No. 069/25/08143 dated 20.01.2026, for providing conservancy services at Air Force Station, Barrackpore through Cantonment Board, Barrackpore for a period of 01 (one) year from the date of signing of contract at a cost of ₹ 90,02,102/- (Rupees ninety lacs two thousand one hundred and two only).

E-tender had been invited by the Board for outsourcing of 17 (seventeen) nos. of Conservancy Staffs (Unskilled Manpower) vide GeM Bid No. GEM/2026/B/7197407 dated 05.02.2026, for a period of 01 (one) year from the date of communication of acceptance of the tender through GeM.


In view of above, the ibid matter alongwith all necessary documents are placed before the Board, to approve the fresh e-tender through GeM for the outsourcing of 17 (seventeen) nos. of unskilled manpower to provide conservancy services to the Air Force troops stationed at Barrackpore Cantonment.




E-tender had been invited by the Board for the provision of conservancy services at Samridhi Shopping Complex, Bus Terminal Open Area and Shaheed Bindee Tewary Street Vending Zone of Cantonment Board Barrackpore for the period of 03 (three) years, from the date of communication of acceptance of the tender, vide GeM Bid No.GEM/2025/B/7053053 dated 29.12.2025.

For the above, total of 14 (Fourteen) nos. of participants submitted the bids in due date and time.

In accordance with the procurement guidelines, a thorough evaluation was carried out by the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC), to ensure fairness, transparency, and compliance.

During scrutiny by the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC), it was found that only 03 (Three) nos. of firms submitted the requisite documents as per Additional Terms & Conditions (ATC) and found them technically qualified.

As per existing GeM protocol, additional 02 (Two) days time period was granted to the remaining 11 (Eleven) nos. of firms to submit the requisite documents as per Additional Terms & Conditions (ATC).

Apropos, after expiry of additional 02 (Two) days, time period, Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC) found that, out of 11 (eleven) nos. of participating bidders, additional 02 (Two) nos. of firms submitted the requisite documents as per ATC and found them technically qualified.

As per recommendation of the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC), out of 11 (Eleven) nos. of bidders, only 05 (five) nos. of bidders have been technically qualified and 06 (Six) nos. of bidders were rejected due to not meeting the eligibility criteria as mentioned in Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) for providing the above mentioned service.

During the Financial Bid evaluation, it was observed that out of 05 (five) nos. of technically qualified bidders, the 04 (four) nos. of technically qualified bidders had quoted the same minimum floor price and showing multiple "L-1". Accordingly, the "Run L-1 Selection" option was exercised for selection of the L-1 vendor. The details of the "Run L-1 Selection" are appended below for kind perusal.



Reference Board Proceedings for providing conservancy services to the military troops stationed at Barrackpore Cantonment by Cantonment Board Barrackpore for a period of 02 (two) years w.e.f 01.03.2026 to 29.02.2028 or from the date of communication of acceptance of the tender.

Station Headquarters Barrackpore vide their letter No. 1010/1/Q2 dated 04.12.2025, forwarded the approval of the GOC-in-C, Eastern Command for employment of 102 conservancy staffs (21 permanent Cantt Board conservancy staffs, 72 outsourced conservancy staffs, 09 additional staffs) and garbage removals services at Barrackpore Military Station for a period 02 (two) years from the date of signing of contract.

Cantonment Board Barrackpore vide letter No. E/III/3/Mil Consy./FY 2026-28/Intimation dated 10.12.2025, forwarded the Draft Bid Documents intended for uploading on the GeM portal for outsourcing 72 (seventy-two) numbers of Conservancy Staff (Unskilled Manpower).

Station Headquarters, Barrackpore vide their letter No. 1010/1/Q2 dated 18.12.2025, conveyed the concurrence of IFA, Eastern Command vide IFA, Concurrence Memo No. IFA/EC/22493/Station HQ Barrackpore/Outsourcing/Conservancy Staff and Garbage Removal Service dated 16.12.2025.

Upon approval of the IFA, EC, Kolkata, of the Draft Bid Documents along with the Additional Terms & Conditions (ATC), necessary changes were incorporated in the Draft Bid Documents, and e-tender had been invited by the Board for outsourcing of 72 (seventy-two) nos. of Conservancy Staffs (Unskilled Manpower) vide GeM Bid No. GEM/2025/E/6984762 dated 18.12.2025, for a period of 24 (twenty-four) months from the date of communication of acceptance of the tender through GeM. For wide publicity, notice was also published in the Bartaman (Bengali daily), Sanmarg (Hindi daily) and the Times of India (English daily).


For the above, total 206 (two hundred six) nos. of firms submitted the bid in due date and time.

In accordance with the procurement guidelines, a thorough evaluation was carried out by the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC), to ensure fairness, transparency, and compliance.

During scrutiny by the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC), it was observed that the IP addresses of 23 (twenty three) nos. of firms were marked red by the GeM due to IP address conflict.

This raised serious concerns regarding collusion, cartel formation, or bid rigging as per Clause 8.1.13 of the Manual for Procurement of Goods (Ministry of Finance) and this Office Part-II Order No. 117C dated 09.06.2023.

After careful scrutiny and deliberation, Technical Bid Evaluation Committee recommended to reject all the 23 (twenty-three) nos. of bids whose IP addresses were marked red by the GeM due to IP address conflict.

Hence, the Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC) recommended to evaluate the bids of only remaining 183(one hundred eighty three) nos. participating bidders.

During scrutiny by the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC), it was found that only 05 (five) nos. of firms submitted the requisite documents as per Additional Terms & Conditions (ATC) and found them technically qualified.


As per existing GeM protocol, additional 02 (two) days time period was granted to the remaining 178 (one hundred seventy eight) nos. of firms to submit the requisite documents as per Additional Terms & Conditions (ATC).


Apropos, after expiry of additional 02 (two) days, time period, Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC) found that, out of 178 (forty-six) nos. of participating bidders, additional 15 (fifteen) nos. of firms submitted the requisite documents as per ATC and found them technically qualified.

Accordingly, the Case File had been forwarded to CFA (Competent Financial Authority) for obtaining its approval for acceptance of total 20 (twenty) nos. of bids as Technically Qualified and rejection of 186 (eighty-six) nos. of bids due non-submission of requisite documents as per ATC/ flagged in red on the GeM portal due to detection of possible collusion based on captured IP address analysis.

Upon approval of the CFA (Competent Financial Authority), out of 206 (two hundred six) bidders, only 20 (twenty) nos. of bidders have been technically qualified and 186 (one hundred eighty-six) nos. of bidders were rejected due not meeting the eligibility criteria as mentioned in Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) for providing the above mentioned service.

The Financial Bid evaluation was conducted on 10.02.2026 in the presence of the Representative of IFA, EC, Kolkata. During the process, it was observed that representations were submitted by 64 (sixty-four) nos. of bidders. As advised by the Representative of IFA, EC, Kolkata, all the representations were examined and rejected on being found insubstantial. Subsequently, the Financial Bids were opened.


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
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During the Financial Bid evaluation, it was observed that all the 20 (twenty) nos. of technically qualified bidders had quoted the same minimum floor price as fixed by the GeM portal and showing multiple "L-1". Accordingly, the "Run L-1 Selection" option was exercised for selection of the L-1 vendor. The details of the "Run L-1 Selection" are appended below for kind perusal.



AGENDA NO. 9: ESTABLISHMENT OF CLIMATE-CONTROLLED HYDROPONICS SYSTEM AT TRENCHING GROUND OF CANTONMENT BOARD, BARRACKPORE

Reference CBR No. 17 dated 14.01.2026.

In order to promote sustainable, space-efficient and technology-driven agricultural practices, Board vide CBR No. 17 dated 14.01.2026, considered and approved for establishment of climate-controlled hydroponics system at Trenching Ground of Cantonment Board Barrackpore. Hydroponics enables soil-less cultivation with efficient use of water, nutrients and space, and is suitable for urban and institutional setups.

Conventional cultivation methods require larger land area, higher water consumption and are dependent on soil quality and seasonal variations. There is a need to adopt modern cultivation techniques that ensure consistent production, better yield and optimal utilization of available space.


The proposed setup will be based on Nutrient Film Technique (NFT) with climate-controlled arrangements. The system will include uPVC NFT channels, nutrient tanks, motors, sensors for EC, pH, temperature and dissolved oxygen, auto-dosing mechanism, microprocessor control system and allied electrical and plumbing works, as per prescribed technical specifications.


The hydroponics system will allow controlled cultivation of crops with higher productivity, reduced water usage and minimal wastage of nutrients. It will also serve as a demonstration model for modern agricultural practices and promote sustainable food production.

The system requires limited area, ensures ease of maintenance, allows real-time monitoring of nutrient parameters and supports year-round cultivation under controlled conditions. It is environmentally friendly and suitable for efficient resource management.

Accordingly, e-tender had been invited by the Board vide GeM Bid No. GEM/2026/B/7181790 dated 02.02.2026, for establishment of climate-controlled hydroponics system at Trenching Ground of Cantonment Board Barrackpore.

For the above, total of 04 (four) nos. of participants submitted the bids in due date and time.



SUPPLY, COMMISSIONING AND INSTALLATION OF TRANSFER CONVEYOR AND CENTRIFUGAL BLOWER WITH LOCKING CHUTE FOR IMPROVEMENT OF OPERATIONAL EFFICIENCY OF THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLANT AT TRENCHING GROUND

In order to improve the operational efficiency of the Solid Waste Management Plant at Trenching Ground, Board vide CBR No. 21 dated 14.01.2026, considered and approved for supply, commissioning and installation of a Transfer Conveyor and Centrifugal Blower with Locking Chute (10 HP) for efficient internal material handling and air-assisted waste transfer.

The proposed Transfer Conveyor will facilitate seamless movement of segregated waste between processing units, thereby reducing manual intervention, minimizing spillage, and improving operational safety. The Centrifugal Blower with Locking Chute (10 HP) will assist in effective air-assisted transfer of lightweight waste fractions, ensuring controlled discharge, dust suppression, and improved segregation efficiency.





Project Summary and Scope:


The core objective is to set up a new Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) Facility with complete door to door underground sewerage network for the entire Cantonment area, including the Civil area, Bungalow area, and Army area, on a priority basis. This is necessitated because the existing practices discharges untreated black water directly into the Hooghly River. Instructions of MOD to do away with septic tanks & soakage pits.

Proposed Sewage Treatment Plant with complete door to door underground sewerage network:

Cantonment Board, Barrackpore needs a new Sewage Treatment Plant (STP), facility with complete door to door underground sewerage network for the entire Cantonment area-

- It has already overburden of drain water of neighbouring North Barrackpore Municipality coming into the three (03) mother drains of Cantonment.
- STPs treat sewage before releasing it into rivers, lakes, or oceans, thereby protecting natural water bodies. Clean and treated water ensures that aquatic plants and animals survive and flourish, Reduces harmful chemicals and toxic substances, helping ecosystems stay balanced which inter-alia to reduce pollution of soil /earth.
- Location: The matter has been discussed in details, regarding Sy. No. 133 & 135.
- Gradient and Network: Considering gradiant of flow of drains and network connectivity to the plant it has been advised for construction of STP at Sy. No. 135 (as detailed later in point 5 of this report)
- DEO, K/C aspect: Further, it has been advised to the DEO, K/C to initiate the process of resumption of OGB No. 28 Riverside Road, at Sy. No. 135 having an area of 3.40 Acres.
- Treatment Mandate: The new STP must follow NGT guidelines, which includes the mandatory provision of tertiary treatment.
- Fragmentation: It was unanimously agreed that a single STP should be considered, with no fragmentation.



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Resolution :

The matter regarding topographical survey to establish a Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) facility along with a comprehensive door-to-door underground sewerage network, was discussed in detail and the President, Cantonment Board, Barrackpore, expressed his reservations and unwillingness for the construction of the STP in the proposed location at Survey No. 135 (Bungalow No. 28) citing health, hygiene concerns and quality of life for the Army Personnel residing in the vicinity of proposed site since 02 Officers' Mess viz. the Brigade Officers' Mess at Survey No. 133 and 02 Sikh Unit Officers' Mess at Survey No. 136 are both within 200 meters of Survey No. 135.

After due deliberation, the Board resolved that the final site for establishment of the Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) facility can only be decided in due course of time in consultation and with the consensus of the Local Military Authority (LMA); or even to ascertain if no suitable parcel of land for STP is available.

Moreover, the Board further resolved that conducting the topographical and related surveys is fundamental at this stage to ascertain the pre-feasibility for the comprehensive door-to-door underground sewerage network and an STP facility. The ibid survey comprises of:

- Detailed topographical survey with contours, benchmarks, spot levels, and base maps.
- Sewer network survey including mapping of sewer lines, manholes, house connections, road crossings, and measurement of invert levels (IL), slopes, and flow directions.
- **Storm water drain** survey covering existing drains, road levels, drainage alignments, and cross-sectional data.
- Identification and mapping of existing utilities and physical features.
- Preparation of all drawings in AutoCAD and GIS platforms

And therefore, it is considered and approved only to carry out the Topographical Survey to prepare a detailed report about a comprehensive door-to-door underground sewerage network covering the entire cantonment area, including the Civil Area, Bungalow Area and Army Area using Total Station/DGPS including contours, benchmarks and invert level survey and route selection for proper digitized map preparation with all necessary field data for Proposal of Sewer and Storm Water Network within jurisdiction of Cantonment Board Barrackpore.

The Board noted that the location for the proposed Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) is yet to be finalized and falls under the discretionary powers of the Cantonment Board, Barrackpore.

After diligent deliberation, it was resolved by the Board that Topographical Survey be carried out by the Lowest Quoted (L-1) agency in a time bound manner and the detailed output of the survey be put up in ensuing meeting of the Board.

It was further resolved that STP shall not be planned at Survey No. 133 & Survey No. 135 due to the reasons aforementioned as opined by the President, Cantonment Board, Barrackpore.





REPAIRING AND RETROFITTING OF OLD RCC WATER RESERVOIR INCLUDING STRUCTURAL REPAIRS, PLASTERING, PAINTING AND FABRICATION & FIXING OF MS STAIRCASE OF OVERHEAD RESERVOIR AT SADAR BAZAR PUMP HOUSE

Reference CBR No. 19 dated 14.01.2026.

The Board, vide CBR No. 19 dated 14.01.2026, had accorded approval for undertaking repair and maintenance of the Overhead Reservoir (OHR) and Underground Reservoir (UGR) at Sadar Bazar Pump House at an estimated cost of ₹ 7.80 Lakhs.

The Overhead Reservoir (OHR) and Underground Reservoir (UGR), set up at GLR Sy No. 34 at Sadar Bazar Civil Area at Pump House are critical components of the water supply system catering to the residents of the Cantonment area under the jurisdiction of Barrackpore Cantonment Board. These reservoirs have been in continuous use for several years and are vital for ensuring safe, reliable, and uninterrupted water supply, since 1979-80.

Subsequent to the Board's approval, a detailed site inspection and technical assessment were carried out by the SAE (Civil) Contractual of the Board. During this process, additional issues relating to structural safety, deterioration of civil components, corrosion of fittings, and public property safety were observed, which were not fully covered in the earlier estimate prepared by the then Assistant Engineer of the Board Shri Partha Saha.

Approx. 844 (Eight Hundred and Forty-Four) numbers of households are connected to the Sadar Bazar Pump House, through which potable drinking water is supplied on a daily basis. The uninterrupted functioning of this system is vital, as it directly supports the day-to-day needs and well-being of ~ 16,000 (sixteen thousand) nos. of people dependent on this supply. Any disruption in the operation of the Overhead Reservoir (OHR) and Underground Reservoir (UGR) of Sadar Bazar Pump House would adversely affect the regular water supply and daily life of the residents. Hence, repair and necessary maintenance of the OHR and UGR at the Sadar Bazar Pump House is essential to ensure safe, reliable, and continuous drinking water supply to the connected households.

Considering public interest, safety of public property, and long-term sustainability of the water supply infrastructure, it became necessary to incorporate additional works and enhanced specifications.




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The revised scope of work includes, inter alia: Comprehensive structural repairs to Overhead Reservoir (OHR) and Underground Reservoir (UGR), crack sealing and advanced waterproofing treatment, thorough cleaning and disinfection of reservoirs, repair/replacement of inlet and outlet pipes, valves, fittings, and allied mechanical components and additional civil and safety-related works required to ensure durability and compliance with public health standards.

Based on the revised assessment, the SAE (Civil) Contractual has prepared a revised estimate based on as per MES-SSR 2020, DSR & PWD Rate Schedule amounting to approximately ₹ 35.00 Lakhs, inclusive of all materials, labour, safety measures, and allied civil and mechanical works.


The scope of works are as hereto:

- a. Dismantling R.C. floor, roof, beams etc. including cutting rods and removing rubbish as directed within a lead of 75 m. including stacking of steel.
- b. Dismantling steel work in built up sections in angles, tees, flats and channels including all Sheets, gusset plates, bolts, nuts, cutting rivets, welding etc. including dismembering and stacking within 50 metres lead.
- c. Removing old paint from blistered painted surface with application of soda, sajimati or any approved chemical paint remover and exposing the original surface including cleaning and thorough washing to remove all traces of the removing agent including taking out shutters and refaxing the same where necessary.
- d. Earth work in excavation of foundation trenches or drains, in all sorts of soil (including mixed soil but excluding laterite or sandstone) including removing, spreading or stacking the spoils within a lead of 75 m. as directed. The item includes necessary trimming the sides of trenches, levelling, dressing and ramming the bottom, bailing out water as required complete. Depth of excavation not exceeding 1,600 mm.
- e. Earth work in filling in foundation trenches or plinth with good earth, Returning, filling in, including spreading, levelling, watering and well ramming in layers not exceeded 25 cm.
- f. Removing corroded worn out portion of reinforcement
- g. Hire and labour charges for shuttering with centring and necessary staging upto 4 m using approved stout props and thick hard wood planks of approved thickness with required bracing for concrete slabs, beams and columns, lintels curved or straight including fitting, fixing and striking out after completion of works.
- h. Chipping of unsound/weak concrete material from slabs, beams, columns etc. with manual Chisel and/ or by standard power driven percussion type or of approved make including tapering of all edges, making square shoulders of cavities including cleaning the exposed concrete surface and reinforcement with wire brushes etc. and disposal of debris for all lead and lifts all complete as per direction of Engineer-In-Charge. 75mm average thickness.



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- i. Cleaning the exposed reinforcement preferably upto full diameter by wire brush, applying two coats of polymer based rust removing compound left for 24 hours, removing the coating and then applying two (2) coats of polymer modified anti corrosive protective coating formulated to inhibit the corrosion of reinforcement.
- j. Mild steel bars 10mm dia and over, cut to length, bent to shape required, including cranking, bending spirally for hooping for columns, hooking ends and binding with and including mild steel wire (annealed) not less than 0.9mm dia or securing with clips, TMT BARS.
- k. Providing and inserting 12 mm dia galvanised steel injection nipple in honey comb area and along crack line including drilling of holes of required diameter (20 mm to 30 mm) up to depth from 30 mm to 80 mm at required spacing and making the hole & crack dust free by blowing compressed air, sealing the distance between injection nipple with adhesive chemical.
- l. Providing and fixing double scaffolding system (cup lock type) on the exterior side, up to seven story height made with 40 mm dia M.S. tube 1.5 m centre to centre, horizontal & vertical tubes joining with cup & lock system with M.S. tubes, M.S. tube chollies, M.S. clamps and M.S. staircase system in the scaffolding for working platform etc. and maintaining it in a serviceable condition for the required duration as approved and removing it thereafter.

Execution of the revised scope of work will ensure structural safety of the reservoirs; prevent leakage, contamination, and potential failure, safeguard public property and public health, reduce the risk of emergency breakdowns and water loss and ensure uninterrupted water supply to Sadar Bazar and adjoining areas


It is submitted that budget provision for the said work/activity exists under the Budget Estimates for FY 2025-26 (Revised Estimates) and FY 2026-27 (Original Estimates).

In view of the above, approval of the Board is solicited for acceptance of the revised estimate of approximately ₹35.00Lakhs for repair and maintenance of the Overhead Reservoir and Underground Reservoir at Sadar Bazar Pump House, in supersession of the earlier estimate.

After installation and commissioning of the system, the operation and maintenance of the electrical infrastructure will be the responsibility of WBSEDCL.



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Subsequently, the Medical Officer In-Charge (MOI/C) reported to the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) on 27.01.2026 that Dr. Arpita Roy was irregular in attending her duties at the hospital. The MOI/C verbally intimated Dr. Arpita Roy several times to attend her duties as per schedule.

On the direction of the CEO, a meeting was convened with Dr. Arpita Roy to discuss the matter. In the said meeting, it was decided as per her request that Dr. Arpita Roy would follow a revised OPD schedule, as detailed below:

- Tuesday and Thursday: 09:00 AM to 02:00 PM
- Monday, Wednesday and Friday: 02:00 PM to 07:00 PM

After about one month, the MOI/C reported to the CEO on 02.03.2026 that Dr. Arpita Roy has continued to remain irregular in attending her duties even after revision of the schedule. Consequently, as per the instruction of the CEO, a gentle reminder was also issued to Dr. Arpita Roy requesting her to attend duties regularly.

Despite the above, Dr. Arpita Roy has not shown any improvement in her attendance and continues to remain irregular in performing her duties, which is adversely affecting the functioning of the Ophthalmology OPD services and causing inconvenience to the patients.

It is further submitted that, as per the panel approved vide ibid CBR No. 3 dated 26.12.2025, Dr. Prasun Bhattacharjee, Ophthalmologist, was placed at the second position in the panel. As per verbal communication with the MOI/C on 10.03.2026, Dr. Prasun Bhattacharjee has expressed his willingness to join J.C. Bose General Hospital, Barrackpore as Ophthalmologist (on contractual basis) in the normal OPD timing.

In view of the above, the Board may consider and approve:
