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AGENDA NO. 4:

REVISION OF REMUNERATION AND RELEASE OF ARREARS IN RESPECT OF DR. AVIK BANIK, AYURVEDA GDMO, J.C. BOSE GENERAL HOSPITAL, CANTONMENT BOARD BARRACKPORE

Dr. Avik Banik, Ayurveda GDMO, J.C. Bose General Hospital, Cantonment Board Barrackpore, vide his representation dated 15.05.2026 to the office of the Principal Directorate, Defence Estates, Eastern Command, Kolkata, requested release of arrears arising out of the revision of remuneration under the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) executed between the Ministry of Ayush and the Directorate General Defence Estates (DGDE), Ministry of Defence.

Subsequently, the Principal Directorate, Defence Estates, Eastern Command, Kolkata, vide letter No. 15/HOSPITAL/GENL/CANTT/EC/DE/IV/23, dated 04.06.2026, examined the matter and observed that:

- The Ayurveda Doctor was deputed by the Ministry of Ayush and the Board is required to abide by the terms and conditions laid down in the MoU executed between the Ministry of Ayush and DGDE from time to time.
- The revised remuneration as per the Addendum to the MoU dated 11.10.2024 is applicable to the Ayurveda GDMO.
- No specific duty hours for Ayurveda Doctors have been prescribed in the MoU and, therefore, revision of remuneration cannot be denied by comparing the working hours of Ayurveda Doctors with other doctors.

The Board, vide CBR No. 5 dated 19.12.2025, approved the revision of the monthly remuneration payable to Dr. Avik Banik from Rs. 50,000/- per month to Rs. 75,000/- per month with effect from December 2025, and payment at the revised rate has since commenced. The financial implication on account of arrears arising from the revision of remuneration for the period from 11.10.2024 to 30.11.2025 (approximately 14 months) is estimated to be around Rs. 3.50 lakh, subject to final calculation and verification by the office. Dr. Avik Banik has requested release of the aforesaid arrears for the period from 11.10.2024 to 30.11.2025. The matter was subsequently examined by the Principal Directorate, Defence Estates, Eastern Command, Kolkata, which advised the Board to take necessary action in accordance with the provisions of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU). So, the Board may consider approving payment of remuneration arrears to Dr. Avik Banik, Ayurveda GDMO, for the period from 11.10.2024 to 30.11.2025, as per the revised rates prescribed under the Addendum to the MoU between the Ministry of Ayush and DGDE dated 11.10.2024.


In this connection, all relevant documents along with the concerned file is placed before the Board for its consideration.

Resolution:

The matter was discussed in detail. After deliberation, the Board decided to defer the item for further examination and discussion. It was resolved that the matter be placed before the Board in its next meeting along with all provisions of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the Ministry of Ayush and DGDE for further consideration and appropriate decision.


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AGENDA NO. 5:

NO OBJECTION FOR LAYING OF UNDERGROUND NATURAL GAS PIPELINE NETWORK TO SUPPLY D-PNG DOMESTIC / COMMERCIAL CONNECTIONS ETC IN BARRACKPORE CANTONMENT AREA

Office Note: Bengal Gas Company Limited (BGCL), vide its letter No. BGCL/PROJ/ PERMISSION/BARRACKPORE CANTONMENT/2026/04, dated 01.06.2026, had requested the CB Barrackpore for grant of No Objection Certificate (NOC) for laying of underground natural gas pipeline network for providing Domestic and Commercial PNG connections within the Barrackpore Cantonment Area.

The proposed network forms part of the Company's authorised City Gas Distribution (CGD) project and is intended to facilitate supply of natural gas to domestic, commercial and other consumers within the Barrackpore Cantonment jurisdiction. Details of Survey Nos. involved is as follows: -

The NOC desired by BGCL is subject to compliance with the Govt. of India, Ministry of Defence Policy No. B/87898/Plg(Lands)/2016/95/SO(II)/D(Lands) dated 27.03.2026 and the conditions stipulated therein, including, but not limited to, the following:

1. Obtaining all requisite permissions from the Principal Director, Defence Estates, Eastern Command, Kolkata.
2. Obtaining prior NOCs/clearances from the State Government and/or other Central Government Departments/Authorities, wherever applicable.
3. Finalization of the pipeline alignment in consultation with the competent authorities after obtaining the requisite sanctions and approvals.
4. Payment of applicable licence fee, lease rent, and other charges in accordance with the prevailing Ministry of Defence policies and guidelines.
5. Restoration of all public assets and infrastructure, if damaged during execution of the work, at the cost of the intending authority.
6. Submission of as-built drawings indicating the exact alignment and length of the pipeline upon completion of the work.



PROVISION OF ENGAGEMENT OF DATA ENTRY OPERATOR IN THE OFFICE OF DIRECTORATE, DEFENCE ESTATES, EASTERN COMMAND, ALIPORE, KOLKATA, DEFENCE ESTATES OFFICER, KOLKATA CIRCLE AND IN THE OFFICE OF CANTONMENT BOARD BARRACKPORE FOR A PERIOD OF 01 (ONE) YEAR FROM THE DATE OF COMMUNICATION OF ACCEPTANCE OF THE TENDER

Existing Contract:

Contract for the provision of engagement of 06 (six) nos. of different category of manpower (viz. unskilled/ semi-skilled/ skilled and highly skilled) in the Office of Directorate, Defence Estates, Eastern Command, DEO, Kolkata Circle and Cantonment Board Barrackpore for a period of 01 (one) year w.e.f 01.04.2025 to 31.03.2026 vide GeM Contract No. GEMC-511687732464360 dated 29.03.2025.

Fresh GeM Contract:

E-tender had been invited by the Board for the provision of engagement of 04 (four) nos. of different category of manpower (viz. unskilled/ semi-skilled/ skilled and highly skilled) in the Office of Directorate, Defence Estates, Eastern Command for a period of 01 (one) year from the date of communication of acceptance of the tender, vide GeM Bid No. GEM/2026/B/7130706 dated 20.01.2026.

Board vide CBR No. 16 dated 06.04.2026, considered and approved the lowest quoted rate amounting of ₹11,40,662.22 of the GeM System Selected firm Vigil Allied Management Private Limited.

This Office vide GeM Contract No. GEMC-511687766605684 dated 06.04.2026, awarded the contract to Vigil Allied Management Private Limited for providing the services for engagement of 04 (four) nos. of manpower of different categories (viz. Unskilled, Semi-Skilled, Skilled and Highly Skilled) in the Office of Directorate, Defence Estates, Eastern Command, DEO, Kolkata Circle and Cantonment Board, Barrackpore for a period of 01 (one) year from 16.04.2026 to 15.04.2027.

No response from the GeM System Selected firm Vigil Allied Management Private Limited:

Reminder-I:

Reference is invited to this office e-mail dated 16.04.2026, whereby official communication was made requesting Vigil Allied Management Private Limited to convey their willingness for providing the ibid services and to submit Rs. 100/- Non-Judicial Stamp Paper for execution of Agreement and Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG), as per contract terms, within 03 (three) days from the date of receipt of the said e-mail.



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Reminder-II:

However, Vigil Allied Management Private Limited vide their e-mail dated 20.04.2026, requested to provide the communication details regarding the subject tender.

Accordingly, this office forwarded the details of concerned official for necessary coordination.

However, no communication, confirmation, or willingness for providing the ibid services was received from their end.

Accordingly, this Office vide letter No. E/1/21/Manpower/Dte. DE EC/2026-27/Reminder-II dated 21.04.2026, issued the 2nd reminder to Vigil Allied Management Private Limited and also reiterated for submission of the following within 03 (three) days from the date of receipt of this e-mail:

- i. Willingness for providing the ibid services immediately, so as to ensure smooth and uninterrupted functioning of the Office of Directorate, Defence Estates, Eastern Command.
- ii. Rs. 100/- Non-Judicial Stamp Paper for execution of Agreement and deputation of their authorised signatory for signing/execution of the Agreement.
- iii. Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) as per contract terms.

This office also intimated that it may be treated as the final communication/reminder in the matter. Any lapse, non-acknowledgement of this e-mail, or non-submission of the above-mentioned documents within the stipulated time shall be treated as gross negligence towards the contract order, and necessary action, including initiation of blacklisting/debarment proceedings against the firm, shall be taken strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions of the tender/contract documents and applicable rules in force.

Show Cause:

Despite issuance of repeated communications and even after telephonic conversation held on 21.04.2026 with Shri Prabir Pal, SI of this office, Vigil Allied Management Private Limited failed to comply with the directions issued by this office. Vigil Allied Management Private Limited neither submitted the required documents nor turned up for completing the necessary official formalities (viz. execution of agreement and submission of Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) as per contract terms), which reflects lack of seriousness and non-compliance on their part.



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Accordingly, this Office vide letter No. E/1/21/Manpower/Dte. DE EC/202627/ Show Cause dated 30.04.2026, issued the Final Reminder-Cum-Show Cause Notice. Failing to submit a satisfactory reply within the stipulated time, it shall be presumed that Vigil Allied Management Private Limited have nothing to state in their defence and appropriate action including blacklisting and reporting on GeM shall be initiated without any further reference.

It was further noted that such inaction is adversely affecting the functioning of the office and is in violation of the terms and conditions of the contract.

In view of the above, Vigil Allied Management Private Limited was called upon to SHOW CAUSE within 03 (three) days from the receipt of this notice as to why:

- i. Vigil Allied Management Private Limited should not be blacklisted/debarred for non-compliance and breach of contractual obligations.
- ii. Appropriate incident(s) should not be raised on the GeM portal against the firm.

Reminder-IV:

This office again vide e-mail dated 12.05.2026, intimated the following:

- i. This office did not receive any PBG till date.
- ii. No agreement, received till date.

It is hereby stated that ample opportunity has been provided to Vigil Allied Management Private Limited to complete the necessary official formalities, including execution of the Agreement and submission of the Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) as per the contract terms. However, the firm has failed to comply with the contractual requirements, which reflects a lack of seriousness and non-compliance on its part.

In view of the foregoing facts and circumstances, this office initiated a GeM Contract Cancellation Request on the GeM Portal on account of delay in mobilisation of services, non-submission of the Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG), and non-execution of the Agreement. The said cancellation request was subsequently accepted by GeM.

Accordingly, in order to ensure continuity of services and avoid disruption in the functioning of the office, an extension was granted to the existing service provider M/s. Chowdhury Construction for a further period of 06 (six) months with effect from 01.04.2026 to 30.09.2026.



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Considering necessary and requirement of services at Dte. DE EC, DEO Office, Kolkata Circle and Cantt. Board, the matter regarding ex-post facto sanction to the existing firm M/s. Chowdhury Construction for a period of 06 (six) months or till new tender is finalized, whichever is earlier.

Accordingly, the matter is placed before the Board for noting and approval.

Resolution : Noted and approved. CEO is authorised to take necessary action in this regard.

Whereas, Air Force Station, Barrackpore vide their letter No. 6W/843/1/Org dated 03.02.2026, conveyed the AON (Approval of Necessity) sanction accorded by the Competent Financial Authority (CFA) vide IFA HQ EAC AON No. 069/25/08143 dated 20.01.2026, for providing conservancy services at Air Force Station, Barrackpore through Cantonment Board, Barrackpore for a period of 01 (one) year from the date of signing of contract at a cost of ₹90,02,102/- (Rupees ninety lacs two thousand one hundred and two only).

And Whereas, Cantonment Board Barrackpore vide letter No. E/1/21/Sanitation/ IAF/26-27/01 Jun 26 to 31 May 2027/EAS dated 21.04.2025, forwarded the case file for obtaining the concurrence of Expenditure Angle Sanction (EAS) of the Competent Financial Authority (CFA) for providing the ibid service.

And Whereas, 6 Wing Air Force Station Barrackpore vide their letter u/r, conveyed the sanction accorded by the Competent Financial Authority (CFA) vide letter No. EAC/2624/4/Org dated 02.06.2026, in consultation with IFA vide UO No. 02/069/26/1/25/08143 dated 01.06.2026, towards outsourcing of external conservancy services at Air Force Station Barrackpore, Air Force Camp Kanchrapara & Air Force Camp Jaffarpore (combined) for the period of 01 (one) year w.e.f 04.06.2026 to 03.06.2027 at a cost of ₹90,02,102/- (Rupees ninety lacs two thousand one hundred two only).

In this regard, the case file alongwith AON & EAS sanction/approval of the CFA (Competent Financial Authority) are placed before the Board for its noting and required necessary action.

Resolution: Noted. CEO is authorised to take necessary action in this regard. Agreement to be executed with 6 Wing Air Force Station Barrackpore for providing the ibid service.

E-TENDER FOR OUTSOURCING OF 17 (SEVENTEEN) NOS. OF UNSKILLED CONSERVANCY MANPOWER FOR PROVIDING CONSERVANCY SERVICES AT 6 WING AIR FORCE STATION BARRACKPORE, AIR FORCE CAMP, IAFFARPORE AND AIR FORCE CAMP, KANCHRAPARA (COMBINED) FOR A PERIOD OF 01 (YEAR) W.E.F 04.06.2026 TO 03.06.2027

Whereas, Air Force Station, Barrackpore vide their letter No. 6W/843/1/Org dated 03.02.2026, conveyed the AON (Approval of Necessity) sanction accorded by the Competent Financial Authority (CFA) vide IFA HQ EAC AON No. 069/25/08143 dated 20.01.2026, for providing conservancy services at Air Force Station, Barrackpore through Cantonment Board, Barrackpore for a period of 01 (one) year from the date of signing of contract at a cost of ₹90,02,102/- (Rupees ninety lacs two thousand one hundred and two only).

E-tender had been invited by the Board for outsourcing of 17 (seventeen) nos. of Conservancy Staffs (Unskilled Manpower) vide GeM Bid No. GEM/2026/B/7197407 dated 05.02.2026, for a period of 01 (one) year from the date of communication of acceptance of the tender through GeM.

For the above, total 392 (three hundred ninety-two) nos. of firms submitted the bid in due date and time.

In accordance with the procurement guidelines, a thorough evaluation was carried out by the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC), to ensure fairness, transparency, and compliance.

During scrutiny by the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC), it was observed that the IP addresses of 58 (fifty-eight) nos. of firms were marked red by the GeM due to IP address conflict.

This raised serious concerns regarding collusion, cartel formation, or bid rigging as per Clause 8.1.13 of the Manual for Procurement of Goods (Ministry of Finance) and this Office Part-II Order No. 117C dated 09.06.2023.

After careful scrutiny and deliberation, Technical Bid Evaluation Committee recommended to reject all the 58 (fifty-eight) nos. of bids whose IP addresses were marked red by the GeM due to IP address conflict.

Hence, the Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC) recommended to evaluate the bids of only remaining 334 (three hundred thirty-four) nos. participating bidders.




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During scrutiny by the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC), it was found that only 06 (six) nos. of firms submitted the requisite documents as per Additional Terms & Conditions (ATC) and found them technically qualified.

As per existing GeM protocol, additional 02 (two) days' time period was granted to the remaining 328 (three hundred twenty-eight) nos. of firms to submit the requisite documents as per Additional Terms & Conditions (ATC).


Upon the expiry of additional 02 (two) days' time period, Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (TEC) found that, out of remaining 328 (three hundred twenty-eight) nos. of participating firms, additional 03 (three) nos. of firms submitted the requisite documents as per ATC and found them technically qualified.


Accordingly, out of a total 392 (three hundred ninety-two) nos. of participating firms, only 09 (nine) nos. of firms had been found technically qualified, having submitted all requisite documents and fulfilled the eligibility criteria as stipulated in the ATC. The remaining 383 (three hundred eighty-three) nos. firms had been rejected during Technical Evaluation due to non-submission of requisite documents and non-fulfilment of the prescribed eligibility criteria as mentioned in the ATC.

The Financial Bid evaluation was conducted on 20.04.2026, in the Office of Cantonment Board, Barrackpore, during the process, it was observed that representations were submitted by 148 (one hundred forty eight) nos. of bidders. As per deliberation and recommendation of Technical Bid Evaluation Committee, all the representations were examined and rejected on being found insubstantial. Subsequently, the Financial Bids were opened.

During the Financial Bid evaluation, it was observed that all the 09 (nine) nos. of technically qualified bidders had quoted the same minimum floor price as fixed by the GeM portal and showing multiple "L-1". Accordingly, the "Run L-1 Selection" option was exercised for selection of the L-1 vendor. The details of the "Run L-1 Selection" are appended below:

And Whereas, Cantonment Board Barrackpore vide letter No. E/1/21/Sanitation/IAF/26-27/01 Jun 26 to 31 May 2027/EAS dated 21.04.2025, forwarded the case file for obtaining the concurrence of Expenditure Angle Sanction (EAS) of the Competent Financial Authority (CFA) for providing the ibid service.

And Whereas, 6 Wing Air Force Station Barrackpore vide their letter u/r, conveyed the sanction accorded by the Competent Financial Authority (CFA) vide letter No. EAC/2624/4/Org dated 02.06.2026, in consultation with IFA vide UO No. 02/069/26/I/25/08143 dated 01.06.2026, towards outsourcing of external conservancy services at Air Force Station Barrackpore, Air Force Camp Kanchrapara & Air Force Camp Jaffarpore (combined) for the period of 01 (one) year w.e.f 04.06.2026 to 03.06.2027 at a cost of ₹90,02,102/- (Rupees ninety lacs two thousand one hundred two only).

In this regard, tender documents of the participating bidders alongwith Technical Bid Evaluation, Financial Bid Evaluation and approval of the CFA (Competent Financial Authority) are placed before the Board for approval and required necessary action.

Resolution :

Noted and approved. CEO is authorized to take necessary action in this regard, including execution of the Agreement with the GeM system selected L-1 bidder for engagement of 17 (seventeen) nos. of contractual conservancy staffs.

PROVISION OF DOOR-TO-DOOR SEGREGATED GARBAGE COLLECTION SERVICES IN THE ENTIRE CANTONMENT AREA INCLUDING HAL, AIR FORCE STATION AND MILITARY UNIT AREAS FOR A PERIOD OF 03 (THREE) YEARS FROM THE DATE OF COMMUNICATION OF ACCEPTANCE OF THE TENDER

Reference GeM Contract No. GEMC-511687716294763 dated 03.08.2023.

Contract for the provision of door-to-door segregated garbage collection services in the entire Cantonment area including HAL; Barrackpore, Air Force Station, Barrackpore and Military Unit areas was awarded to GeM System Selected Lowest Quoted firm for a period of 03 (three) years w.e.f 07.08.2023 to 06.08.2026.

The ibid conservancy contract is set to expire on 07.08.2026.

It is pertinent to mention that the existing rate for collection of door-to-door segregated garbage in Barrackpore Cantonment is ₹272/- per quintal (100 kg). On an average, approximately 2,370 quintals of segregated waste are collected every month.

The existing rate has remained unchanged for nearly 03 (three) years. During this period, the cost of POL (Petrol, Oil and Lubricants), minimum wages, and other associated operational expenses has increased significantly. Accordingly, the proposed rate of ₹300/- per quintal (100 kg) for collection of door-to-door segregated garbage in Barrackpore Cantonment represents an increase of only about 10% over the existing rate.

In view of the above, the approximate monthly expenditure for collection of 2,370 quintals of segregated waste at the proposed rate is calculated and appended below:

It is also submitted that the budget provision has been made for procurement of the ibid service/activity for Budget Estimates for the FY 2026-27 (Revised Estimates) and 2027-28 (Original Estimates).

Hence, considering the above stated fact e-tender for the provision of door-to-door segregated garbage collection services in the entire Cantonment area including HAL, Barrackpore, Air Force Station, Barrackpore and Military Unit areas may be called for a period of 03 (three) years via Custom Bid through GeM portal.

All documents including Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) alongwith Scope of Work and all Annexure(s) viz. Minimum Rates of Wages and applicability of EPF & ESIC, etc. are placed before the Board for its consideration.


